March 2020 → August 2020

After 2 more weeks of practice and learning our teammates names we started the games. For the first game when it started there was a small drizzle and later into the game it started to down-pour. Half way through the game, my teammates figured out what I can do very well, headers. Every time the opposing team's goalie got the ball and drop-kicked it I would run up from my spot at defence and head it right back toward their goal for someone on my team to take. Later on into the season in a game I was able to go into offence and as soon as I got the ball I was up at the opposite side of the field and scored a goal. After that game at the end of October my family and I went to get our new dog and we decided to name him Remmy after the famous hunting brand Remington and we named him that because he was a hunting dog. But not too long

later we figured out that he wasn't socialized at all by the people we bought him from because he was afraid of everything. Once winter came I asked my parents if they could sign me up for snowboarding at Lab mountain. Later that day they told me that they couldn't because the price had almost doubled because of covid. Later on into winter I got invited to go snowboarding with the Kidas at Song Mountain but we had to keep our masks on the entire time because of covid. When I got to Song mountain Oliver and I came up with a game that we could play while going down the mountain, covid tag. In the game it was just like regular tag but instead of having to touch eat other we just have to get within 6 feet of each other and say tag and then the other person is it. Later on we got board of playing covid tag and decided to try and find new trails that we haven't been on before.
