# My Covid Experience

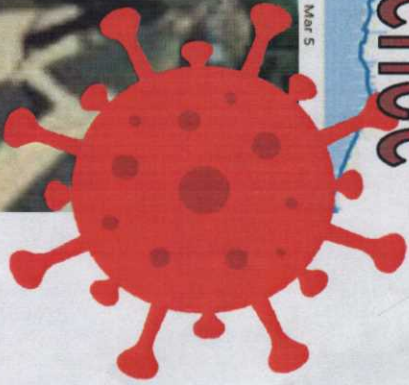
